Dear Mr. Reams:

Congratulations on the approval of your Geometric Improvement project at US-69: McKay Intersection (Radii only). Your project will be included in the Kansas Department of Transportation (KDOT) fiscal year 2021 City Connecting Link Improvement Program (CCLIP).

KDOT has approved funds for this project based on an estimate for the total project cost of \$375,000. The state's participation will be up to a maximum amount of \$400,000 for the actual total participating project costs (CE and construction). The city will be responsible for all remaining project costs over the \$400,000 maximum and any costs that are determined to be non-participating.

The project plans will require review by KDOT's Bureau of Local Projects for compliance with KDOT's procedures and requirements.

The Project Manager from the Bureau of Local Projects will be contacting you to discuss this procedure, as well as developing a schedule to advance the project to a timely bid letting.
