

City Council Meeting Minutes

August 17, 2020

The meeting of the Frontenac City Council, August 17, 2020, was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Mayor Fornelli. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all.

Roll call was answered by Mayor David Fornelli, Tom Sighel, LaDonna Pyle, Mike Snow, Lynn Grant, Joe Martin, Pat Clinton and David Hogard. Marc McCully was absent.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Clinton to amend the agenda to add Blue Cross Blue Shield Pathways Grant between line 6 and 7. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Minutes from the August 3, 2020, council meeting was opened for discussion. Hogard made a motion, seconded by Pyle, to approve the minutes. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Appropriation Ordinance #1773 was opened for discussion. A motion to approve Appropriation Ordinance #1773 was made by Grant, seconded by Martin. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Carol Gossett, on behalf of the Senior Citizen Center, presented the Council with an updated rental agreement as well as signs that are on display at the Senior Citizens Center. She asked the Council to allow the facility to be allowed to host rental events. City Attorney Angermayer addressed the council on the liability the City bears since the facility is owned by the City. After much discussion, the Council decided to table the opening for events to the next meeting.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Sighel to table event rentals at the Senior Citizens Center until the next meeting on September 8th. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Hogard to approve the agreement between the State of Kansas Department of Commerce and the City of Frontenac and all supporting documents for CDBG-CV Agreement Number 20-CV-083. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Snow made a motion, seconded by Martin to approve the \$5,000.00 sponsorship to Festa Italiana. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Zafuta informed the Council that the City has been awarded \$16,500.00 through the Blue Cross Blue Shield Pathways Grant. This grant will be used to create lighted gravel walking paths throughout City Park, the paths will come close to a distance of one mile.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Snow to accept the Blue Cross Blue Shield Pathways Grant and allow the Mayor to sign all supporting documents. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Grant made a motion, seconded by Pyle to open the public hearing for the 2021 Budget at 7:15 p.m. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

There were no comments regarding the 2021 Budget.

Grant made a motion, seconded by Clinton to close the public hearing for the 2021 Budget at 7:17 p.m. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Pyle made a motion, seconded by Martin to approve the 2021 Budget. The motion was voted upon and unanimously approved by the Council.

Zafuta gave a high-level overview of the numbers regarding the City's sewage treatment options, that being the Regional Sewer Plant or the City having a stand-alone Sewer Plant.

Martin made a motion, seconded by Clinton to approve the City moving forward with their own Sewer Plant. The motion was voted upon by a roll call vote and unanimously approved by the Council.

City Administrator’s Report:


